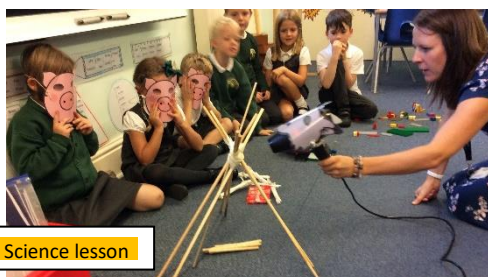
Class 1

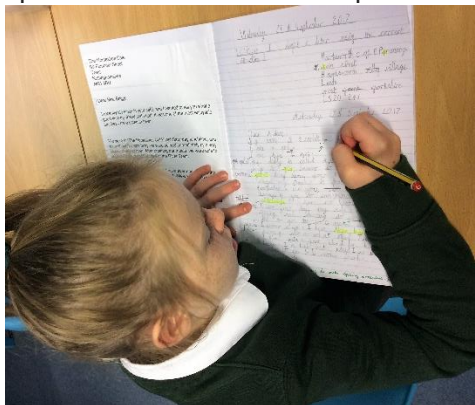

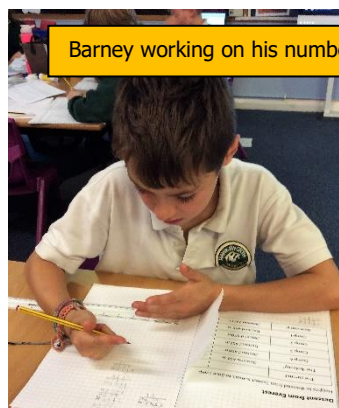


Scarlett writing a formal letter – great cursive handwriting!
