Harry for great improvement in his writing and cheering his Grandparents up by writing to them.

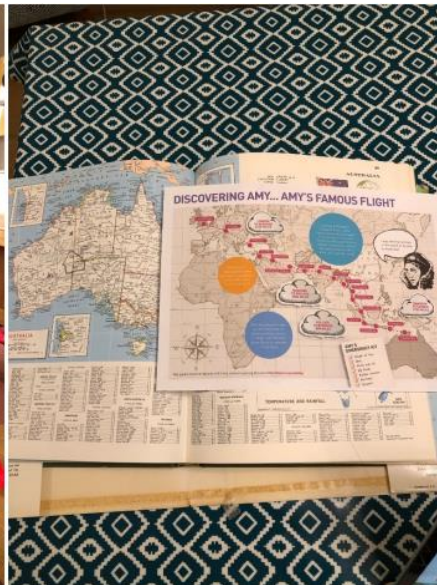
Charlotte for completing all her Purple Mash work.

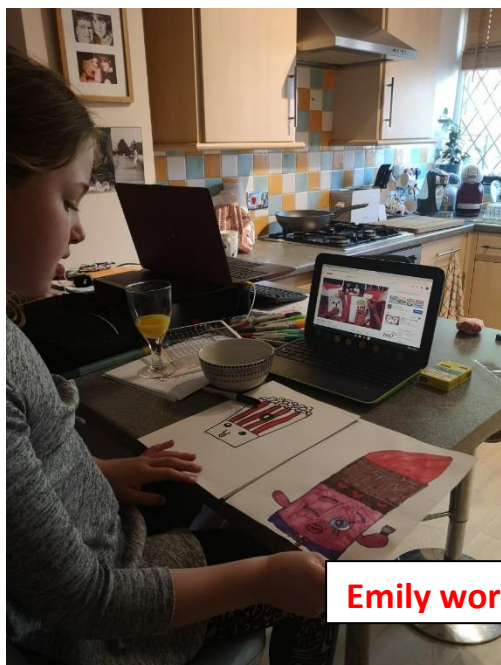


Isolation Inspiration

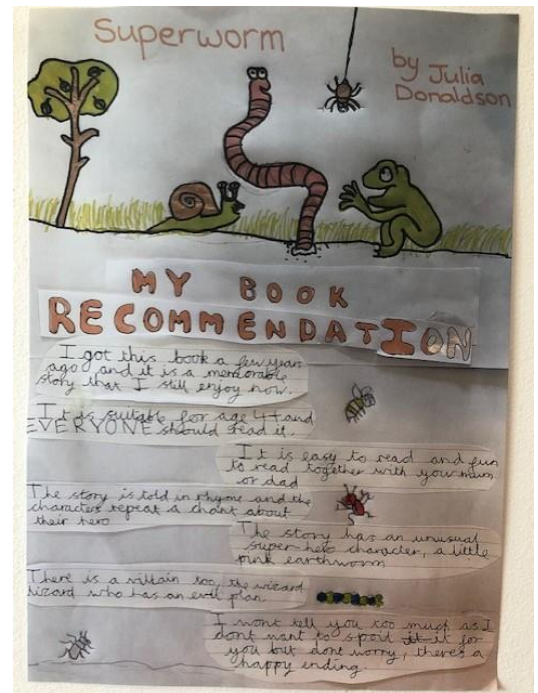


Zoe made a puppet theatre and performed a show for her family! Well done Zoe and cast!
