## School News

### Covid – 19

During this pandemic we had done very well and only lost one bubble for a day just before the Christmas break in 2020 but in the last two weeks we have seen a high number of positive cases in staff and across the school.

As you may be aware today we closed the Class 2 bubble due to a number of positive Covid tests. Today's closure now leaves only the Class 4 bubble unaffected but takes our total for staff self-isolating to eleven. With only Mrs Bowers, the kitchen staff and I in school, Mrs Hyde kindly volunteered to come into school on her non-working day to fulfil our designated safeguarding ratio...she is a star!

Thankfully, we will have the Class 3 bubble return to school on Monday and three staff members. The Class 1 bubble's last day of isolation will be Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July and so return to school on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July. Class 2 will return to school on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

Duration of self-isolation dates have all been provided by Public Health based on the data they have received.

Going forward all the local schools have decided to continue to follow present guidance from Leeds City Council and bubbles will remain until the final day of the school term. Below is an excerpt from the latest guidance to Leeds Heads:

### *Advice from Leeds*

*In Leeds, our school term runs beyond 19<sup>th</sup> July and we are aware that leaders are now having to decide whether to maintain bubbles until the end of term.*

*Having discussed this with some primary and secondary head teachers as well as with public health and Health and Safety colleagues, the local authority is of the opinion that **you should continue to follow your existing risk assessment and control measures until the end of term.** If you have events and visits planned for the end of term, you will already have planned these in a Covid secure way and you should continue to apply the control measures you had planned.*

### Sports Day

Unfortunately, Sports Day did not occur today and the final decision to cancel it was when I received news this morning that a third bubble had collapsed. We are hoping to have Sports Day on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July in bubbles and unfortunately parents will not be able to attend, especially with the recent closure of classes and in light of Leeds CC advice.
